Data-Based Individualization

Data-Based Individualization (DBI) is a systematic method for using data to determine when and how to provide more intensive intervention.

Throughout the DBI process, the teacher collects daily/weekly data about the intervention and the student's progress and makes changes accordingly.

Multiple evaluations to collect data on teacher implementation/skills and student outcomes
