NCII Progress Toward Outcomes (Year 1)



The mission of the NCII is to build knowledge and capacity of state and local leaders, faculty and professional development providers, educators, and other stakeholders to support implementation of intensive intervention for students with severe and persistent learning and/or social, emotional, or behavioral needs using data-based individualization (DBI). The Progress Toward Outcomes report is an annual report summarizing NCII's progress toward meeting project goals.

Activities by Service Area



- Convened a **Thought Leader Summit** on assessment practices for English learners (ELs)
- Incorporated new tools and interventions in the six NCII tools charts
- · Began developing resources to support educator assessment of ELs
- Developed a visual tool to share the effectiveness of academic interventions


